- What are your long and short-term career goals and objectives, and how are you preparing to achieve them?
- Why did you choose your career?
- What do you consider to be your greatest strengths and weaknesses?
- How would you describe yourself? How would a friend or professor describe you?
- How has your college experience prepared you for your career?
- Why should I hire you?
- How do you determine or evaluate success?
- In what ways do you think you can make a contribution to our company?
- Describe the relationship that should exist between a supervisor and those reporting to him or her.
- Describe your most rewarding college experience.
- If you were hiring for this position, what qualities would you look for?
- What led you to choose your field or major?
- What have you learned from participation in extracurricular activities?
- How do you work under pressure?
- Describe the ideal job.
- Why did you decide to seek a position with this organization, and what do you know about us?
- What major problem have you encountered, and how did you deal with it?
- What criteria are you using to evaluate the organization for which you hope to work?
- What salary do you want?
